At a young age soccer became a huge part of Tim's life as he started off playing for Bristol Youth Soccer and went on to participate in different leagues throughout the East Coast. As an alumni of Mt. Hope High School and Division 1 captain of the soccer team, Tim made a huge impact on his peers, and the community. He moved on to college and became a part owner of the family construction business and began his ventures into Real Estate. In 2010 Tim was diagnosed with Hodgkins Lymphoma. After undergoing many rounds of chemo treatments and radiation Tim lost his battle in 2012 at the age of 27. He was such a fighter and kept a very positive outlook on life, he never gave up. Tim has become a huge inspiration to many and leaves behind a wonderful legacy.

The DaPonte Family and Mt. Hope High School Athletics teamed up in 2013 to create THE PERFECT 10 TIMOTHY DA PONTE MEMORIAL SOCCER TOURNAMENT to raise money, which then awards a high school senior soccer player with a scholarship for college. This year we are trying something different and are teaming up with Bristol Youth Soccer to create a fun-filled, all day family event called Timothy DaPonte Memorial Day where all of Bristol Youth Soccer's teams will be participating in friendly match ups. The past four years we've awarded \$1,000 scholarships to a graduating senior going to college and made a \$1,000 donation to Dana Farber Institute/Jimmy Fund.
